Dear Parents/Guardians:

Newport News Public Schools will be administering the Virginia Standards of Learning (SOL) assessment to students enrolled in courses listed in the table below will be administered the corresponding SOL assessment if needed to satisfy the verified credit requirement for graduation or for the assessment needs to be used to satisfy federal accountability for the student. If you need clarification on whether the student needs the verified credit for graduation, you can follow up with the student’s professional school counselor.

For students in hybrid (in-person learning) option, SOL assessments will be administered on the days the student is at school anyway. Communication will be delivered via email to parents/guardian of students that are in the virtual option to obtain transportation requests. On that email, parents/guardians can communicate the decision to forgo NNPS transportation and notify the school that they will be making their own arrangements to get the student to and from school.

Schools will set specific testing dates within the following windows:
